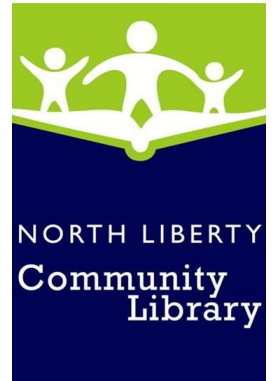


Junior Volunteer Application

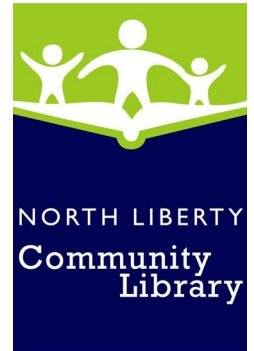

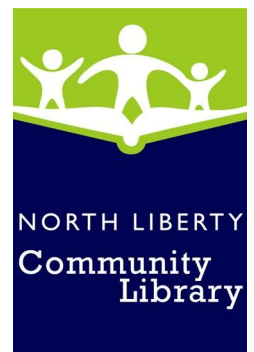
