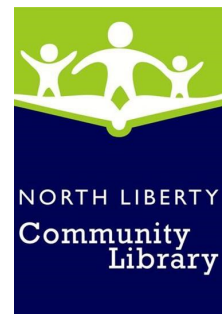

As a Volunteer:

- ◆ Shelf Read (go to a section of the library, for ex. Teen A-D ,and make sure they are in order by author & title)
- ◆ Shelving
- ◆ Check CD/DVD cases for discs
- ◆ Special tasks as assigned by library staff
