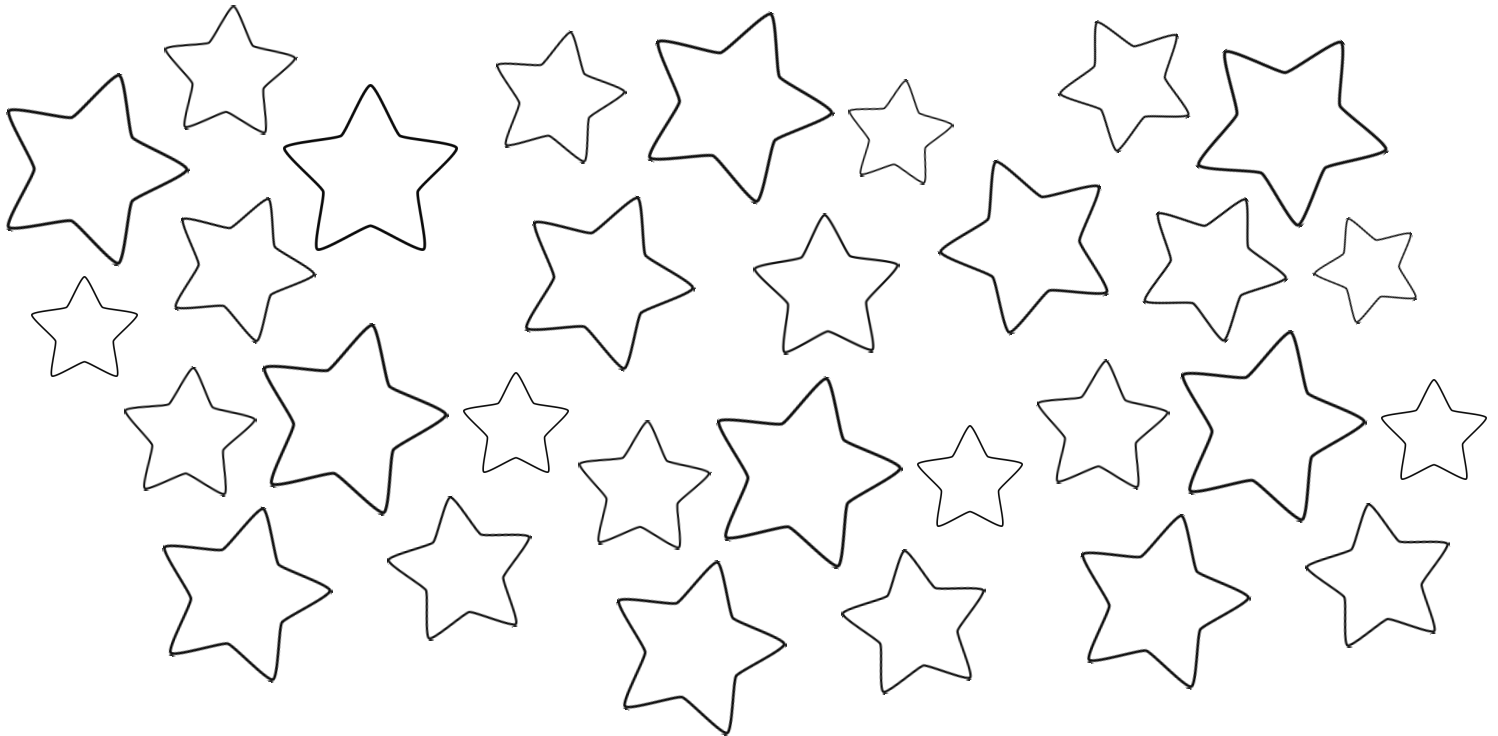
## Family Reading Challenge

## **ACTIVITY IDEAS**

Talk about items in the grocery store

Blow Bubbles

Sing a nursery rhyme

Drum on pots and pans

Act out a fingerplay, such as "Pat-a-cake"

Show your child family pictures and tell them about each person

Dance along to different types of music

Talk about what sounds you hear outside

Show your baby black and white contrast photos

Play Peek-a-boo

Play with water outside or in the sink

Visit the library and check out a Big Book Activity Kit

Mimic sounds or words and use different inflections

Look at a touch and feel or lift flap book

Learn the word for 'moon' or 'star' in a different

While outside identify basic colors (green grass)

Sing ABCs to your child

Spend 5 quiet minutes rocking your baby
