
## **ACTIVITIES FOR BABY-PREK AND EXPECTING FAMILIES**

Activities can be modified based on the age and ability and may be repeated.

- Take a walk, talk about things you see and hear
- Dance along to different types of music
- Include child in mealtime prep talk about food and different tastes
  - Ask your child basic questions name, age, birthday, where they live
  - Create a photo album with family photos and talk about each person
- Let your child read their favorite story to you
- Make a keepsake for baby or have child create a one of a kind masterpiece.
